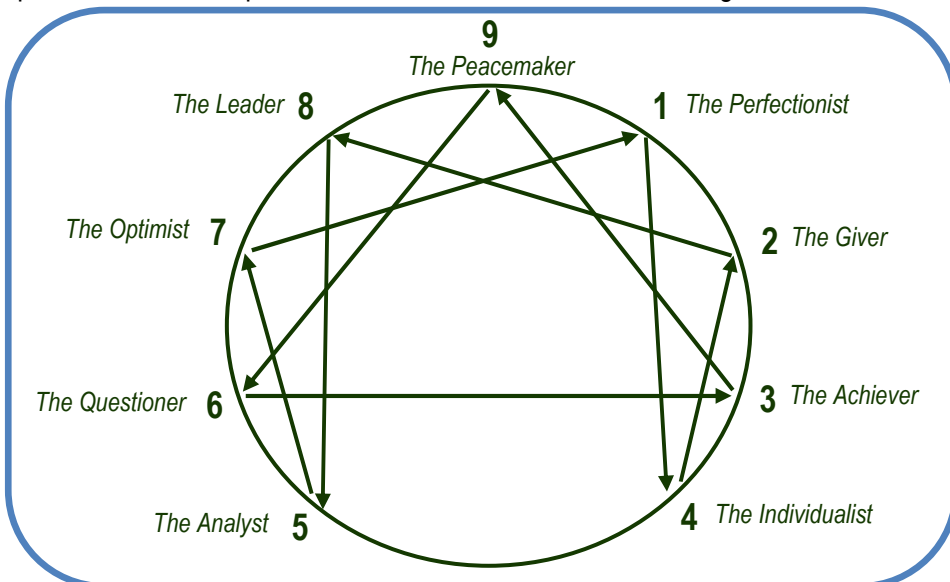
Conscious Leadership Workshop

Becoming a Conscious Leader

The challenge of leadership is tailoring your approach to get the best out of those you seek to lead. But every person is different. Conscious leaders recognise these differences and modify their approach based on an understanding of people's needs, motivations and values.

In this conscious leadership workshop you will learn to apply a highly effective tool for personal understanding, development and transformation: the Enneagram. Understanding Enneagram profiles will assist you in interacting effectively with people that you work alongside or manage. It is an excellent tool for improving professional and personal relationships, communication and overall functioning.



You will learn:

- How to better understand your own personality and your unconscious motivations**
- How to better manage a team through increased understanding of human personality**
- The keys to personal success through increased self-awareness**

Presenters Rob Noble and Dr Veronica Lunn will use the Enneagram profiling tool to give each participant a core understanding of their own personality type, how to self-manage effectively and how to better lead others.



Rob has had over 30 years in local government, 25 of those years in senior management positions in two states. He held the position of CEO for large councils in Queensland for 17 years. He also served as the Queensland and National President of LGMA.

Since 2002, Rob has focussed on helping people develop individual and group self-awareness in a range of contexts, including his own and within other organisations and community groups.



Veronica also has a strong background working in local government with over 20 years in senior management in NSW. She has been a finalist in the NSW Telstra Business Woman of the Year and has lectured at Newcastle University and the Hunter Institute of Technology in both management and the humanities.

Both Rob and Veronica are accredited Enneagram practitioners and teachers and over the past six years have worked with the corporate and private sector helping people achieve higher levels of awareness and an understanding of self and others.
